

The above graph shows the continuation of Tarcenay/road in comparison to Woodham (see Arkell) and Mount Hermon (see Haas), both *Mariae* chron. Striking is the nearly total missing of *Cardioceratids* at Mount Hermon (Syria) and the disappearing of *Peltoceratids*.

The appearance of *Creniceras Renggeri* seems to mark the beginning of the Renggeri marl. Striking as well is the abundance of *Hecticoceratids* at Mount Hermon (Syria) and Tarcenay, compared to Woodham (GB)
